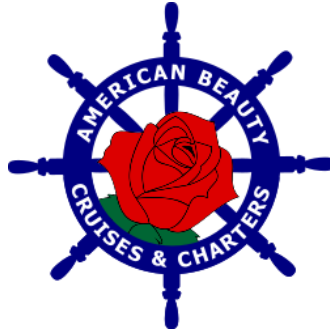


90 Minute Nature Cruise

- Hear tales of pirate treasure, prohibition rum-runners, and fierce naval battles during the **War of 1812**.
- Departing the historical landmark of Long Wharf, once the hub of global whaling commerce.

Sail Past Stunning Protected Lands of Sag Harbor Sound



- Mashomack Preserve – over 2,000 acres of pristine woodlands, marshes, and coastline teeming with wildlife.
- Barcelona Neck & Grace Estate – rich in biodiversity and archaeological significance.
- Cedar Point Lighthouse – a sentinel of Sag Harbor’s seafaring past.



Ecology and Wildlife of the Peconic Estuary

See salt marshes, estuaries, and forest habitats home to ospreys, herons, deer, turtles, and even harbor seals. Every season offers something new— from spring peepers and summer nesting birds to winter wildlife tracking.

Sag Harbor Cultural Gems

We cruise past Cormaria Retreat, historic African-American communities like Eastville and Azurest, and learn how these neighborhoods shaped Sag Harbor’s inclusive legacy.

And as when we finally pass the historic South Ferry on the return to Long Wharf, take in the windmill monument and reflect on the community’s enduring spirit—where heritage, nature, and storytelling unite.
